

DIRECTIONS TO TILLERY CAMPSITE

FOUR WHEEL DRIVE IS RECOMMENDED FOR THE PATH TO THE TILLERY CAMPSITE AFTER A PERIOD OF RAIN!!!!!!

Note that at the Tillery campsite, fires are permitted in the fire ring **ONLY**.

From Greenville, NC, Take Hwy 13/11 North to Oak City. At the only stop light (across from a Red Apple Market), turn left on Hwy 125 and travel to Scotland Neck. In Scotland Neck, take Hwy 258 to where Hwy 561 turns off to the left toward Halifax (before the Roanoke River Bridge). Take the left on 561 and travel several miles till you pass the Tillery Volunteer Fire Department on your left. Watch for Over the Farm Road and take a right on it, then left on Boone Road. When Boone ends in a T-intersection, you will go right on Roanoke Drive. Go about a quarter of a mile until you see a wooden frame farmhouse with a blue metal roof. Take a left on the dirt road leading to the house, but continue past the house and through the field. Go right when the path comes to a T-intersection. Watch closely for the metal roof of the screened section of the camping decks; it may be difficult to see during summer when the trees are leafed out. You may park on the dirt path by the campsite.

From I-95.....Take the Hwy 903 Exit toward Halifax. As 903 comes in to Halifax, take a right onto 301/903/125 South and travel 2-3 miles. Take a left onto Hwy 561 toward Tillery. After about 8 miles, watch for Over the Farm Road and take a left, then follow the rest of the directions set out above (picking up with the left on Boone Road).
